

Post-Flood Rehabilitation Activity Report From Badhan

Date: Oct 31, 2004
Location: Kashiram village of Tushvandar union in Kaliganj thana under Lalmonirhat district
Team: 15 Badhan volunteers
Beneficiaries: Approximately **154 families** (~616 persons)

Description of activity:

On Oct 31, 2004, a Badhan volunteer team distributed items in Lalmonirhat as part of its post-flood rehabilitation program. To facilitate income-generating activities, goats were distributed to 90 flood affected families. To help flood victims rebuild their houses, bundles of corrugated iron were distributed to 64 families. This rehabilitation program was supported by funds sent from SpaandanB.

The Badhan team visited and assessed the area on multiple occasions before choosing Kashiram village. Badhan has provided flood relief at many locations in several districts affected by the floods. Based on first hand experience, they regarded Kashiram village in Lalmonihat as one of the most needy places. Most of the villagers are extremely poor and needy. All of the beneficiaries chosen are day workers and have no consistent source of income.

The 15-person Badhan team went to Kaliganj on Oct 29, 2004 and stayed there till Oct 31, 2004 to complete the rehabilitation program. The local administration of Kaliganj and the administration of Karimuddin Degree College helped Badhan execute the rehabilitation program.

Each beneficiary family was visited at their home by the Badhan team and was given some preconditions so that they feel obligated to make best use of the support provided. To ensure proper usage of the items provided, Badhan teams are scheduled to visit the beneficiaries in October/November 2004.
