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- **Title of the -project:** Technology Transfer for Self employment within flood affected people
- **Location of the Project:**
Forty unions, 19 Thanas under 13 districts in Bangladesh. These are- Tangail, Bogra, Sirajgang, Kishoregang, Myemenshing, Sherpur, Netrokona, Gaibandha, Kurigram, Lalmonirhat, Brahmanbaria, Sunamgang Hobigang

- **Name of technology to be transferred:**

1. Goat rearing
2. Skill Training

- **Short description of the technology:**

In the proposed project area the economic condition of the flood affected people are very poor. They lives hands to mouths. Moreover flood swept over all. Economic rehabilitation are urgently needed which can be done by providing income generating activities. Our experience says that skills training, goat rearing program, and provide Rickshaw/Van is very fruitful program for our rural people by which they will able to earn money. These technologies are very helpful for poor peoples for income generating activities. Goat rearing is very much profitable because of its high values and easy technology. This project is highly suitable for rural women.

Skill Training

After flood a high number of young women and men in different unions are frustrated for loss their own resource and loss of their income source. Our expectation through skill training they will take self generating activities. As a result peoples' capabilities will increase to support educational expenses, treatment cost for good health etc. Training will for Mushroom cultivation, Tailoring and in Handicrafts

Provide Rickshaw/ Van and Sewing machine

In rural areas flood affected people have not find out their current income source. Some of peoples hiring rickshaws /van from owner. But every day they have to pay Tk.100 to owner. So, at end of day they do not have sufficient money left for family requirements. This project will be helpful to improve their quality of life.

- **Objectives of the project:**

- Socio-economic conditions of the flood affected people will improve.
- Animal protein shortage will be fulfilled in the area.
- Employment opportunity especially women employment will be created.
- Availability of sufficient organic manure in the project area.

- **Methodology:**

1. Formation of Local Committee

Hunger Volunteers will motivate and organize the target group to form Local Committee to implement the different component of the project.

2. Technology transfer

Necessary practical training will be given to the stake Holders on goat rearing and de-worming technology. Through demonstration and discussion meeting this technology shall be disseminate among the stake holders. During implementation of the project by the rural people, problems shall be identified and through practical training problems shall be removed.

3. Contract between stakeholder and local committee:

- This project will be properly implemented by the stakeholders and local committee jointly.
- When the goat gives birth of kids for the first time , one kid after leaving milking will be transferred to another member and the mother goat will remain the property of the original recipient. The new member in turn will also transfer the first kid. In this way the program will continue.
- For Sewing machine & Rickshaw Vans the recipient will pay to the local committee @ Tk. 10 & Tk. 20 per day respectively to the local committee and in about a year will repay the cost . When the cost is repaid fully the recipient will be the owner of the sewing machine/Rickshaw will be the

Capacity building of stakeholders

During implementation of the project necessary foundation training will be given to 200 stake holders. Others skill training like cultivation of mushroom. handicrafts etc will also be provided for self employment.

Plan of operation

Implementation of the project has the following factors:

- Selection of Recipients
- Procurement and Distribution
- Monitoring and Follow up

Selection of Recipients

The Hunger Project- Bangladesh has trained rural Youth for Voluntary services, who are called Animators. The main function of the Animators is to inspire the target group in participating and guiding them successful completion of the project. The animators are not paid staff. They will receive only for actual transportation cost for implementing the project. The local animators will survey and prepare the list of families, who need and willing to participate in the program. The requirements received from the different families will be reviewed and consolidated in the Head office in Dhaka.

Procurement and Distribution of Goat

The goat will be procured from the local market by the assistance of our local committee. These goats will be distributed to the pre-selected families in the rural area, which will be monitored and Co-coordinated by the local committee, Area office & Head office (The Hunger project) Dhaka.

Procurement and Distribution of Rickshaw/Sewing machine

Rickshaw/Sewing machines will be procured by Head office from the distributors for economy and will be distributed by the Local Committee under the supervision of the Animators

Only one item/ services will be allowed to each family.

- **Proposed activities to be carried out:**
 - Preparation of work plan
 - Selection of working area.
 - Selection of stakeholders
 - Foundation training where necessary
 - Follow-up training where necessary
 - Purchase of goat and distribution
 - Purchase of Sewing Machine and distribution
 - Purchase of Rickshaw Van and distribution
 - Group meeting/ Discussion meeting.
 - Observation

- Motivation.
- Marketing assistance
- Monitoring and Reporting.

• **Expected Output/Results:**

- Introduction and acquaintance with modern technology of goat rearing
- Introduction and acquaintance with modern technology of Mushroom cultivation
- Introduction and acquaintance with the technology of Handicraft making
- Financial Improvement
- Life style Improvement in the target area
- co operation among the rural population through co operative activities
- Reduction Protein deficiency in the target area
- Introduction of Income generation activities.
- Reduction of unemployment through Self employment of rural population.

Estimated Budget:

The project will be implemented in 40 Unions of the 10 districts as per list enclosed. About 200 families will be selected for goat rearing project, 50 families will be selected for Rickshaw/ van & 30 families will be selected for sewing machine. Total families selected will be 300.
